## OPEN TO THE PUBLIC

Jim confirmed and the board acknowledged the resignation of Chris Ferekides, directing the school to convey its gratitude for his years of service on the on the board.

# Principal's Report Evan

- 1. Evan notified the Board that the team is currently on pace.
- 2. Evan shared with the Board that FTE for Survey 2 is at 366.
- 3. Evan shared attendance data with the Board. 30 students are currently at risk, compared to 44 students this time last year.
- 4. Evan reviewed the academic dashboards with the Board. 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> grade are currently 2 areas of concern for testing this year. There are some concerns about the fidelity of the data, as students who are currently participating in online learning are testing at home. We'll have a better idea of where our students are academically when we return to 100% traditional learning.
- 5. Evan asked the Board for approval to return to 100% traditional learning. There are concerns about the achievement gap that is widening between students at home and students in school. Many of our students participating in online learning are not doing well. The Board approved the return to traditional learning.

MANAGEMENT REPORT - Dan

- Monthly financial reports for Sept 2020
  The financial reports were reviewed and unanimously adopted. Dan reported that the school's expenditures exceeded revenues by \$34,279 YTD. This includes the costs for curriculum, FFE and other upfront expenditures that were budgeted. The school's fund balance was \$577,019 or 17% of annualized revenues. Cash was \$1,135,343-, or 125-days cash on hand.
- Budget review after Oct FTE Count Mandatory
   The board received the budget presentation given by Dan Rishavy, and based upon recommendation and review, it took no action to amend the budget.
